Re: Road Construction of Kellogg & Webb/KTA Interchange

Dear Resident/Property Owner:

The City of Wichita has contracted with **Wildcat Construction** to construct the above referenced project. A public information meeting for the project will be held on **August 11, 2015**, at the **Summit Church, 10225 E Kellogg, at 6:00 PM**. Construction is slated to begin in mid-August with a projected completion in late 2019. However, as with many construction projects, these dates are dependent on weather conditions and the potential for delays if unforeseen conflicts are encountered.


This project will improve Kellogg to a 6-lane freeway from Cypress to just west of Greenwich. Improvements include an interchange at Webb, one-way frontage roads on both the north and south sides of Kellogg, new traffic signal at Webb, and a new traffic signal at Corporate Hills. Construction will also provide storm drainage improvements, waterline improvements, sidewalk, aesthetic elements and landscaping of available right-of-way.

During construction, two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Kellogg and Webb Rd. at all times. At some point during construction, left turns will be prohibited at the Kellogg and Webb intersection. Message board signs will notify motorists several days in advance of any lane and road closures. Access to businesses will be maintained. Driveways within the project limits will be reconstructed, with modified access provided as possible. Intermittent flagging of traffic may occur during work hours.

Ultimately, these improvements will be of lasting benefit, not just to those in the immediate area, but also to the City as a whole. However, as with any public improvement project, those impacted by construction will realize temporary inconvenience. Please know that we will make every effort to minimize the inconvenience to you and the traveling public, and that your support and cooperation is critical to ensuring the success of the project.
